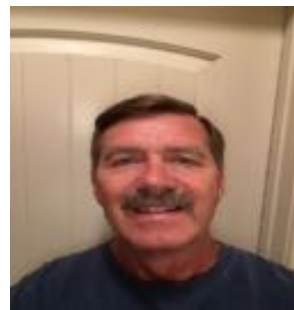
Greetings Brother Knights,
