Chaplains Message

Greeting my brother Knights,

It is hard to believe but the season of Lent is once again upon us, and we are blessed to be given this time for prayer, fasting, abstinence and good works. Just a reminder that Ash Wednesday is February 17th and we will be having five liturgies on that day. We will be having a morning mass at 8:00 a.m. with the distribution of ashes to follow and another mass in the evening at 5:00 p.m. followed by the distribution of ashes. We will have two additional liturgies of the word on Wednesday, at noon and at 7:00 p.m. and these two liturgies are outside the context of the mass. We have an additional mass with ashes at 10:00 a.m., but that is reserved for our school students so that they can experience the beginning of the Lenten season with a Mass and ashes. A reminder that also during Lent, every Friday at 7:00 p.m. we have The Way of the Cross and we encourage as many of our families as possible to attend this wonderful Lenten devotion. A last reminder about Lent.....Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence, meaning no meat on those two days and only one full meal should be consumed on those two days. This measure of course does not apply to anyone with any medication condition or has reached the age of 59. I hope that we can all use this season of Lent to perhaps not just "give up" something but perhaps to "Add In" something.... maybe an extra few minutes of prayer or silence or scripture reading.... anything that can help bring us closer to the great celebration of the Easter Triduum and the Resurrection of our Lord. We will also have evenings of reconciliation throughout the Lenten Season.....our Evening of Reconciliation will be on Thursday, March 4th from 7:00 p.m. till 9:00 p.m., we hope you and your family will make every effort to take advantage of this season of Lent as a time of preparation, reparation and contrition. I continually pray for all of you my brothers and your families in this continued time of pandemic, may you remain safe and healthy and let us remember all of our health care workers in this difficult time.
