KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS YOUTH FREE THROW CHAMPIONSHIP COUNCIL & DISTRICT LEVEL WINNERS



Since 1972, councils have sponsored the Knights of Columbus International Free Throw Championship for boys and girls between the ages of 9 and 14 (starting in the fraternal year 2013-2014). For most if not all the time our Brother Chris Huggins has been the point man organizing the event.

The Knights of Columbus Free Throw Championship involves a series of competitions that begin at the <u>Council level</u> and proceeds through to the <u>District level</u>, to the <u>Regional level</u>, and finally to the <u>State level</u>. To be eligible to participate from one level to the other requires the competitor to be a 1st place winner. As shown below, we have 1st place winners of the <u>Council</u> and <u>District</u> level competitions that are now eligible to participate in the <u>Regional</u> competition.

We thank all the youth who competed in the <u>Council level</u> Knights of Columbus Free Throw Championship on Tuesday, 1/23/18 and again on Friday, 1/26/18 in the <u>District level</u>. The competitions wers very close in several age brackets. Tie breakers were needed to determine a winner in two categories. This made for some strong competition and excitement. One participant in the <u>Council level</u> made 12 out of 15 shots and better yet, one of our participants in the <u>District level</u> made 20 out of 25 free-throw shots.
