


Mittie Woods 07/25/29 - 01/26/20

Amen






Youth Group from the Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux hosted by Council 802 for breakfast on their return from the National March for Life Rally






Flease continue to pray the Rosary to end Abortion in our lifetime


