MESSAGE FROM FATHER JOHN

For being the shortest month of the year, February manages to pack in quite a bit. We start with Groundhog's Day and then there is Valentines' Day, which I am sure all the ladies enjoy if you fellows don't forget.

This year Ash Wednesday is February 15th and the Season of Lent begins. Fr. Mark Link, S. J. in his reflection for the day says, "Our big danger today not that we will fast and make a big show of it. Our big danger is that we will not fast at all.

We think fasting is harmful. In his book, FASTING: THE ULTI-MATE DIET, Dr. Alan Cott takes issue with this notion. He insists fasting does not harm adult health. On the contrary, it often benefits our health.

Dr. Cott cites the example of Japanese soldiers hiding in the jungles of Guam and the Philippines, 30 years after World War II had ended. They were in better health than were their countrymen in Japan.

Dr. Cott also notes that British citizens enjoyed better health during the period of food rationing in World War II than during the period when food was plentiful."

Lent is a beautiful time for each of us to take a good look at ourselves and see where we are in the eyes of God and what need improving in our lives. It is a time to put God first, our neighbor second and ourselves third.
