

- > The Declaration of Independence placed everything the Patriots held dear (their lives, their fortunes and their honor) in danger of sheer destruction.
- ➤ The Declaration of Independence is a relevant document important to the survival of our country today.
- It helps define us a land of the free.

We remember the women and men who spent their personal and professional lives working to make things better, not only for themselves, but also for their families, their communities and our nation; not just for their generation, but also for the millions who came after them.
