


Race for Life in Memory of Chuck Washington

Mia is a sassy, energetic 3 year old. She loves pink! Minnie mouse is her favorite character; although Doc Mcstuffins got her through her hospital stays.

She was originally diagnosed with T- Cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia at 15 months old. She endured about 10 months of intense chemotherapy while contacting some life-threatening illnesses along the way, before starting a maintenance chemo regimen. We celebrated 1 year cancer free in March, 2016. Shortly after, she relapsed in May. After living at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and then in a close by apartment for 100 days post transplant, Mia was able to move home on November 19, 2016. She is 4 months post transplant at this point and is doing great. She is thrilled to be home playing with her two older, amazing brothers!




