In memory of Jake The Tank and in support of the Honig family

Race for Life in Memory of brother Chuck Washington

Jake the tank Honig was 7 years old and battled with brain cancer for most of his young life. His fight inspired his community. The beautiful memories sustain his family as they deal with his passing, and they feel so grateful and blessed to have had him. This young man was an inspiration to all who knew or read about him.

At 2 years of age (2012) Jake was diagnosed with a high grade glioma brain tumor. He underwent a 7 hour brain surgery, 14 rounds of chemotherapy and 28 rounds of radiation for over 1 year at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. Jake was in remission until a routine MRI scan in April of 2017 showed the brain tumor had returned. Jake underwent a 5 hour brain surgery, 6 rounds of chemotherapy and additional 33 rounds of radiation.

In December 2017 an MRI was done after Jake complained of pain in his back, and this testing found that the cancer had spread to his spine. Jake's cancer was then considered uncontrollable.

Jake loved video games, the Golden State Warriors and Steph Curry, eating junk food, and playing games with his sister Gianna. He was a fantastic big brother and his sister was with him every step of the way through his illness. His smile was contagious and he maintained a positive attitude no matter what life threw at him.

He was known as the Tank because of the strength he showed during the years he fought the cancer. An old soul with a positive spirit, he was beloved by his friends in the Howell Township Police Department, and he was named an honorary police officer.




