CPT Mike "Reaper29" Sweetland Task Force Reaper Camp Marmal, Afghanistan Deputy Grand Knight Council 4962

In early January 2014, I was stationed at Camp Marmal Afghanistan in Regional Command North. The only Catholic Mass said in all of Regional Command North was done by CPT Father Tom Mastin of the 524 CSSB. Father Tom was out on the edge of nowhere and with little support from higher headquarters 200 miles away at Bagram Airfield. At New Year's Day Mass he said that he did not have any Missals for the coming year. I decided to email Ed Columbus and the Knights of Council 4962 to see if there was anything to be done. Ed came through and said that the Council could ship 50 Missals (10 more than Father Tom requested). As I was scheduled to rotate out by February 1, 2014, I told Ed to go ahead and I'd let Father Tom know that Missals were enroute (pardon the pun). Figuring it would take time to get Council approval, the missals purchased, packaged and shipped. I didn't think there was any way that I would be there to see a Mass given with the new Missals. Both God and Council 4962 came through in flying colors, the last day that I was in the country the boxes arrived and Father was able to perform Mass that night with the new Missals. I felt an overwhelming sense of success that the Council came through not just for me but for the hundreds, if not thousands, of troops that would benefit from those Missals over the coming year. That year has now ended and I want to extend my thanks, appreciation and admiration to all those who made it possible. Father Tom was certainly appreciative as it made his job easier at Camp Marmal and all the far flung outposts he and his successor had to visit throughout Regional Command North. Thanks again and may you all have a very blessed new year!
