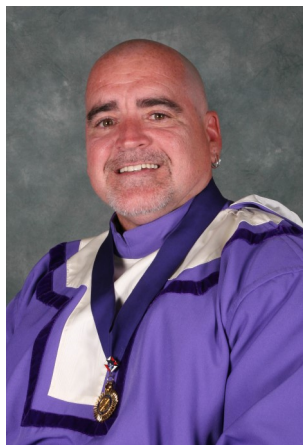

The winter poker league has begun. Every Monday at 7:30 in the bar area. Thanks to PCCP Rich Russo for running the league.

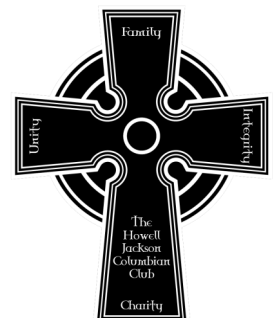

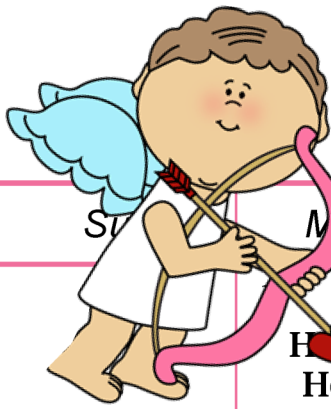
the usual K of C 50 50 😊)!!! Thanks also to Pat O'Connor. for providing a photo collage of 'old timer' photos on the big screen TV.

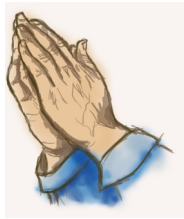
