#### K of C Charity Golf Tournament – Benefits Christians Persecuted by ISIS



The continued, rampant persecution of Christians in the Middle East is well documented. Testimony presented to the U.S. Congress in 2015 by Knights of Columbus Supreme Knight Carl Anderson, helped lead to the Congressional declaration of this

persecution as genocide. Since that time, the Knights of Columbus has donated nearly \$2 million dollars to support Syrian and Iraqi Christians remaining in their homeland and those fleeing this persecution.

The Holy Spirit Knights contributed the proceeds of its first Charity Golf Tournament in 2016, more than \$5000, to Knights of Columbus Charities for this cause. On Friday, May 19, 2017, we will host the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual Charity Golf Tournamant, again to benefit these persecuted Christians. This year, our goal is \$10,000. All of our Knights are asked to participate in the tournament, as golfers or volunteers, and promote contributions and sponsorships toward this worthy cause.
