

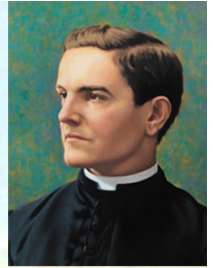

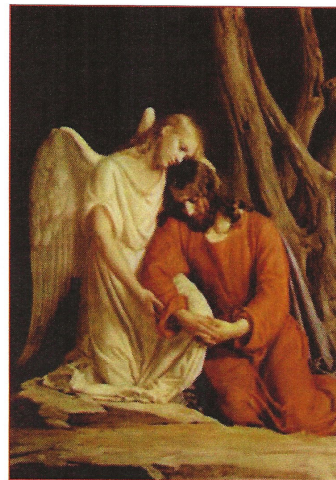

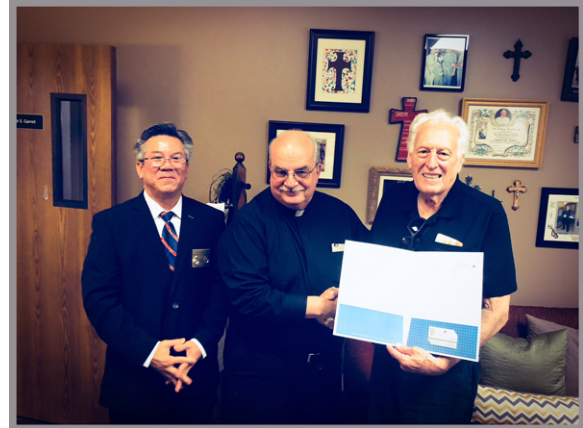

Almost all abortions occur after the baby's heart has begun beating. Teenagers in the US have 216,000 abortions each year.
