My Brother Knights,

The Supreme Court of the United States struck down Texas' abortion facility regulations in a 5-3 decision, the Court sided with abortionists to subject pregnant mothers to substandard safety conditions.

Abortionists are no longer required to secure admitting privileges at a nearby hospital, nor meet the health standards of an ambulatory surgical center. If the law were to be upheld, all but 8 abortions mills would have closed in Texas. However, because the Court sided against the provisions, 18 abortion centers will continue operating with substandard conditions.

Texas Right to Life's legislative work has led to the most closed abortion facilities in the nation since 2012. There are only four abortionists in the United States who will commit the gruesome abortion procedure so late in pregnancy. A recent feature at the anti-Life website Jezebel told the tragic story of a woman who chose to undergo an abortion just eight weeks shy of her due date.
