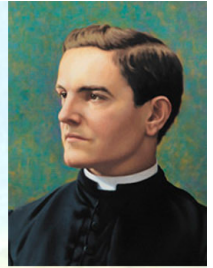

For example, when a woman has the opportunity to see her unborn child through an ultrasound screening and receives loving support at a pro-life resource center, the de-humanizing choice of abortion becomes clear. We stand in solidarity with all who courageously witness to the truth of our humanity and help to build a culture of Life.

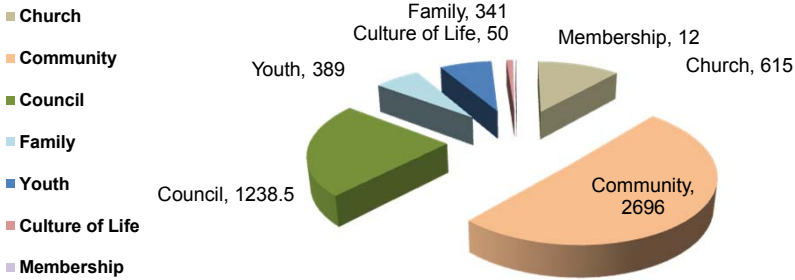

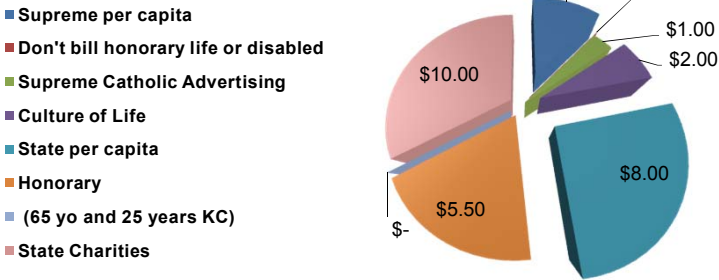
How Your Efforts Breakdown

This is how 5341.5 hours break up as of: **MAY 2018**



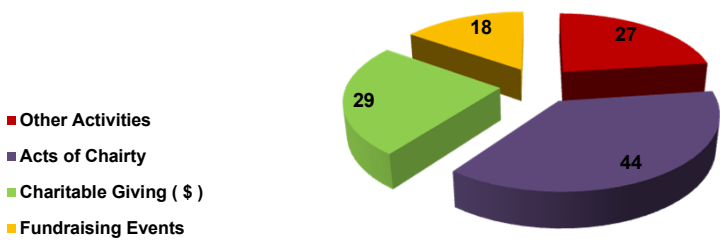
