

Deliveries of wheelchairs from three San Antonio parishes (Holy Trinity, St Francis of Assisi and, St. Mark's) were made to four of the Christus Santa Rosa hospitals (CSRH) in San Antonio and New Braunfels by Knights of Columbus members from the three Councils.

Thanks to the leadership of Sam Szalwinski, we were able to empty the 18 wheeler trailer that was filled with nearly 300 wheelchairs and get them transported on schedule.

An official blessing ceremony for the donated wheelchairs took place at the CSRH Children's hospital on December 10. Archbishop Gustavo conducted the blessing.
