Grand Knight's Letter

Brothers All,

December was a good month for the Council. Our Council Christmas Party, chaired by Mike D'Aiuto, went well with a good turnout and some fun with the gift exchange. Rich Martin organized the Children's Christmas Party with refreshments and another stellar visit by Santa.

Our first blitz of the Columbian Year brought us 5 new applicants who are scheduled for Admissions Committee review followed by their First Degree Exemplification here at Fr. Cilinski Council on 04 Jan 2011. We'll plan for another blitz, perhaps in Feb 2011. Be sure to welcome our new Knights and encourage their participation in our Council activities in the coming year.

In this traditional time of New Year's Resolutions, let's reflect on our participation in council activities in the past year, and the potential level of participation that we may be able to shoot for in the coming year. In the next few months we have a range of activities that we have traditionally supported, and will continue to support. In each of these, there is likely an opportunity for participation that will match your availability. Most importantly, we need new and fresh ideas from you all about how to use the range of capability and talent that this great group of men has to offer. Let's look around and try to identify some needs that we might be able to address for the Church, Community, Family, Youth, the Unborn, or the Council, either as individual Knights, as teams, or as a Council.

You all should have received your annual dues letter by now. As indicated, our fixed costs have risen significantly over the life of the Council, with no increase in dues or initiation fees. However, our revenues from Council fundraisers have concurrently, decreased. In the first half of this Columbian Year, we

found ourselves in a situation where a significant loss on a fundraiser could have put us in deficit. In the second half of this Columbian Year we will be instituting changes in forecasting, controlling and reporting of expenditures, revenues and cash flow to clarify our financial position on an ongoing basis, and to help ensure that the cost and revenue estimates for Council Program activities are reviewed and included in the planning for these activities. This will be done with as little time impact as possible.

We have also inaugurated a By-Laws Committee to:

- 1. Establish what are the current, properly approved By-Laws governing the operation of the Council.
- 2. Determine what is the proper process for amending the By-laws, including what approvals may be required to effect a change in by-laws.
- **3.** Propose changes to the By-Laws that may be of benefit to the Council.
- 4. Identify and/or document the Council's Operating Procedures to ensure consistency with the Charter, Constitution, and Laws of the Knights of Columbus Governing the Supreme, State and Subordinate Councils.

A charter for the operation of the By-Laws Committee will be the first order of business for the committee, and the Committee Chairman will report on the status of the committees work at each regular business meeting.

I look forward to your comments, suggestions, criticisms and participation as we work through these initiatives.
