Gotten a new home or cell phone number? Switched email addresses? Updating the Council – and your Website preferences – is simple.

On the home page (kofc10947.org), click on **MEMBERS LIST**. Enter your Membership Number and Password (your birthdate in mmddyyyy format) and click **SUBMIT**. A list of Council members will appear. Scroll to your name and under the silhouette (or picture, if you've uploaded one for yourself...) click **UPDATE**.

A new window will appear, containing your membership information as it currently exists on the Master List maintained by Supreme. Scroll down to the Please Correct This Information section and make any necessary corrections. These corrections go to the Financial Secretary for processing and ultimately make their way into your records with Supreme as well.

While you are on this page, you can also manage your preferences relative to the display of your birthday on the Council Calendar and remove your name from the Council email list (although doing that will keep you from being updated on important Council news and activities... so we really don't advise doing this!)
