Items to be bulletinizing

Our Council By Laws require that we give notice to the Council membership any request of funds that are \$500.00 or more. This is to let all Brother Knights of the Council have an idea of what is taking place of major significance. We have two items at this time to present:

- 1. A motion at the October Council meeting was made, seconded and passed to add to the \$4,200 (30%) from our 2017 Fish Fry proceeds an additional \$2,518.00. This would bring the Council Contribution to \$6,718 or 50% of the net profit.
- 2. A motion was made at the December 2017 Council meeting to donate \$1,000.00 to First Choice Pregnancy Services. The motion was seconded and passed.

Annual Membership Dues


