FR. BOB'S CORNER

The wonderful Christmas season! We celebrate with joy. We want everyone to have what the Christmas cards say: peace, love and joy. But unfortunately, that is not what we always get. Christmas arrives to find our health precarious (if you have children you can almost bet that there will be sickness over the holidays; our careers, jobs or vocations under stress; our finances dipping badly; our relationships in need of repair; our society and world either slightly or wildly insane.

Thinking of the difficulty we have even personally to celebrate what Christmas is all about, it is interesting to know that, so far as scholars can tell, the church originally celebrated three feasts in the calendar year: Resurrection, Pentecost and Epiphany (which means manifestation). The feast of Epiphany celebrated several major manifestations of Jesus, including his birth, the adoration of the magi, his baptism by John and his first miracle at the wedding in Cana. What all those events have in common is that they were "introductions" of Jesus to the world.

The Western church later marked the feast in three parts, now celebrated as Christmas, Epiphany (limited to the magi) and the baptism of the Lord. Eastern churches have, for the most part, retained the ancient custom of celebrating all the manifestations on one date, a date different from December 25.

As we celebrate our feasts of Jesus Christ being introduced into the world, we are filled with hope because Jesus is among us, he is our light and our life. We celebrate the manifestation of Jesus, whose coming shows God's decision to be part of the world's celebrations and pains, its joys and woes.

A Blessed Christmas, Merry Little Christmas (Epiphany), a wonderful Christmas Season to all of you and your families.
