
A NEW KNIGHT HAS JOINED OUR COUNCIL



SK Stephen Rohrbough, Council Bingo Operator shown below, provided a check for \$3,000 to the Council as a distribution from the Blanco Bingo Unit net profits for the 1st Quarter's 2017 successful Bingo operation. We not only welcome this money, but we now can make added donations to deserving Council Charities.

SK Rohrbough provided an in depth 'State of the Bingo Union' report about Bingo Operations in the five charity Unit operation. This distribution is our first in over a year due to reduced revenues brought about by 8 months of road construction on Blanco Road and the resulting reduced Bingo Player attendance. SK Rohrbough said "We have bounced back from a difficult time and are now ready to receive Bingo distributions from Blanco Bingo Unit more frequently in the future".

THE WHEELCHAIR PROJECT

SK Sam Szalwinski, shown below at the May Council 7613 meeting, discussed the current progress of the Wheelchair campaign and requested that our Knights volunteer to manage the tables in the gathering area- of the June 3 & 4 Masses. For a very interesting wheelchair story, see the video at the end of this section.

At all the June 3 & 4 Masses, SK Sam requested that the congregation stop by our KOC table in the gathering area and make a wheelchair donation to help make immobile people mobile.

SK Sam Szwalinkski is in his 10th year of heading up the acquisition and distribution of wheelchairs to those in need. Described below are a number of Sam's remembrances and wheelchair activities regarding his "wheelchair ventures" that was included in his talk at the June 3 & 4 Masses.

- 1. At the very first distribution, which took place in Nuevo Laredo, Chris Lewis, the President and CEO of the American Wheelchair Missions, told us to give the recipient a hug to show full appreciation of what we were doing. Due to the tears shed by the recipient and myself, I was assured that we did not have to speak each other's language to know our thoughts of gratitude.
- 2. A man on steel pipe crutches weighing about 10 pounds each tossed his crutches on the side of a grassy mound as he received his wheelchair. He said in Spanish that he did not need these heavy crutches anymore. Later that day, we saw him on a street corner in his wheelchair shining shoes.
- 3. The saddest memory of all is in regards to a lady just west of Mexico City who had lost both legs at her groin in an automobile accident. During the wheelchair distribution, she asked a priest serving with us from California if he could prophecy when her legs would grow back. I did not hear his response but can only imagine the challenge he faced.
- 4. Every major city in Mexico has a Rehab Center for children up to age 18. About four years ago such a center was built in San Antonio in the vicinity of Wurzbach Parkway and Thousand Oaks. Each time that we have distributed wheelchairs at several of these Children Rehab Centers including the one in San Antonio, either the children or their parents have presented us with thank you notes.
- 5. In the United States we have distributed many wheelchairs twice in Selma Alabama and three times in San Antonio. The wheelchairs have been donated to Clergy Retirement Centers, the Christus Santa Rosa Hospitals, the Audi Murphy VA Hospital, the CRIT Center and many individuals in need.
