1 – The scoring system for the “Peoria” is where the scoring is made from three pre-picked holes on the front 9 and for 3 similar pre-picked holes on the back 9.

2 – The scoring system for the “Low Total Score” is based on which team has a total score that is lower than that of the other teams.

WHEELCHAIR FUNDRAISING

Chris Lewis, shown below speaking at the St. Mark's Mass on June 10, is the President of the American Wheelchair Mission. Chris Lewis's presence to help celebrate our tenth anniversary of this ministry and his words of encouragement also lent to the success of this wheelchair event. He has been raising funds, not only through the Knights of Columbus, but also the Rotarians and many major companies and individuals. He is the son of Jerry Lewis (deceased). He travels worldwide distributing thousands of wheelchairs in many countries to include Latin America, the Caribbean, Philippines, Vietnam, Israel, VA Hospitals in the US, Clergy Retirement Homes and many other places. He has been doing this for 18 years.

PGK/SK Sam Szalwinski, shown below speaking at the St. Mark's Mass on June 10, said the following:

“The St. Mark's wheelchair program is in its 10th year and it has always been successful. Over these years we have distributed over 2,000 wheelchairs. Some of our parishioners have gone on several distributions to Mexico, particularly to CRIT centers and to Selma, Alabama. Our fund raiser just conducted during June 9-10 has raised almost \$40,039, the most in ten years and more is expected in the next few days.

I especially thank all of the Knights who welcomed Parishioners and accepted their donations at our table and a great big thank you to those who accepted credit card donations which accounted for nearly one half of total donations. The amount raised over that weekend will purchase 267 wheelchairs.

May God continue to bless all who made this event successful.”
