

#### Thought for July

Some Catholics don't understand or believe in purgatory. They think it's unfair of God to make us suffer after death as well as in life. The Church speaks of "fire" in Purgatory. But since after death we will have no bodies until the resurrection we can't suffer physical pain. But we can suffer spiritually. What might that be?

Well, after death we are judged...We will go to Heaven or Hell. Probably most will be judged worthy of heaven. But it says in the Bible that nothing imperfect will enter heaven. Most of us are imperfect even though our sins are forgiven. The Protestant view is that, for those who are saved, at the instant of death they are made perfect and so go straight to heaven. The Catholic Church says that while God loves us and is merciful; He is also just, which is the reason for Purgatory

Now the two Great commandments are love God and love your neighbor and most of us don't love God perfectly or our neighbor. Much of the time we ignore Him although He never ignores us. You can't love someone very well if you ignore them. In Purgatory you will learn just how wonderfully God did love you while you lived and still does. The pain comes from realizing that you ignored His Love. You will be joyful because you know you are going to heaven but you will suffer. That's the strange thing about joy; you can suffer and be joyful at the same time.
