Thought for July 2017

The only reason God created the universe and us is because of His love. God needs nothing except our love in return for His Love. For God's love to be perfect he needs another to love. That's where we come in. The results of love are wonderful...happiness, strength, companionship, lower stress, comfort, enabling self-worth. The results are wonderful. But how do you measure love, how can you show it to the one you love; only by sacrificing, by giving something to them, by putting up with something for them, or by suffering a little so as to come closer to them. If they have a little habit that bothers you, you can smile and bear it because you love them. In other words, suffering and sacrifice are the only measures of love, the only way you can show your love to the one you love. Most of us don't undergo great suffering or sacrifice. Little things mean a lot too. Remember those two great Commandments? The first one is... Love God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength. It's reasonable that God might want to know how much we love Him. He already knows of, course, but we might not know ourselves. So he sends little sufferings and sacrifices to us sometimes to ask us how much we love Him. Or He waits for us to think of him and show him our love by little things...taking time to pray...by putting up(with an easy heart and no anger) with a driver who irritates us or almost hits us...getting up a few minutes early, or skipping dessert. A desert is gone in a few minutes but the reward for giving it up for love of God is eternal. Pay attention to God and show Him your love. That strengthens your love of your neighbor too. You can do no better than that.
