Pit Passes are \$30 regardless of age. Included in the admission ticket is an infield pit party from 6:00pm - 7:00pm where fans can meet monster drivers and


take pictures with the trucks. Presale of tickets (\$2 discount) begins June 28th at the ticket booth at Valley Speedway.



My Brother Officers & Directors:


Because I will be out of town, we need to move our August meeting to the second Tuesday, August 13th.
