Put First Things First

In his book Seven Habits of Highly Effective People, Stephen Covey gives some great advice about how to live our lives more fully. I am not a motivational speaker nor self-help guru, but I think each of his habits have implications for us to consider as Catholic Christians in how we live our lives.

I want to focus on his Habit #3 – "Put First Things First". In his book, he shares that we should live our lives focusing on what is most important, not what is most urgent.

What is the difference between that which is urgent and that which is important? Stuff that is urgent is stuff that has to be done right now - I've got to pay the mortgage by the due date - I have to finish this newsletter by its deadline (oops) - we have to net at least 11 new members by June 2012 to make Star Council again. Urgent things may very well be important, but not all urgent things are that important.

But things which are important are things that are very close to us. Our relationship with our spouse – our relationships with our children – our faith and love of God. Important things are very close to our core being. They may also be urgent, and we should make them urgent - but often they are things we think we can put off until there is more time and we aren't as "busy" as we find ourselves right now.

Personally, it is hard for me to discern the

difference between what is important and what is simply urgent, yet not that important. The best advice I've been given is to take some time on a regular basis – daily, if you can – and during prayer, ask God to guide you towards focusing on that which is most important to Him. I find when I do, I have no trouble discerning who and what is important – and thus who or what I ought to spend my time on.

This topic came to mind last month in a big way for me. I'm not in the Confessional, so I won't share the details – but through some periodic "introspection time" I force upon myself (every year around my birthday), I realized that I had been spending a LOT of time on a number of very urgent things - many of them important also, but some not so much. And there were some important things - but not really urgent that I had been putting off working on, thus committing sins of omission towards some important people in my life. I have recommitted myself to do better and put some measures in place to try and maximize my chances of doing so.

I encourage each of you to take time to focus on that which is important. "Live each day as if you'll die tomorrow" is a motto some use – asking God for guidance is another. Focusing on that which is important will, I believe, make us more holy and better disciples of Jesus. **Vivat Jesus!**
