### THE WHEELCHAIR PROJECT FOR 2016

Our PGK Sam Szalwinski gave a presentation at the May 18 Chapter meeting regarding this year's progress towards obtaining the much needed funds for the wheelchair project. He urged all of the Councils in our archdiocese to increase their efforts for the project – progress seems to be somewhat slower than it was last year.

At the conclusion of Sam's presentation, the Grand Knight of Council 5262, Larry Espree, presented a \$750 check to Sam for the cause (see picture below). At a cost of \$150 per wheelchair, Council 5262 has essentially paid for 5 wheelchairs out of a total goal for all Councils of 200 wheelchairs (\$30,000).

Council 7613 members will lead St. Mark parishioners in our annual wheelchair fundraiser at all Masses on the weekend of 4-5 June, 2016.

As of 21 May the San Antonio Archdiocese has raised a little more than \$15,000 which will purchase 100 wheelchairs. Knights of Columbus wheelchair fund raising in Texas has led parishes to raise \$170,000 so far this fraternal year. By the end of June, this year, we expect the total amount of funds raised in Texas to reach \$200,000. This will purchase 1333 wheelchairs and will make that number of IMMOBILE people MOBILE.

Parishioners participating in this program are meeting our Pope's wishes to help our neighbors in the Jubilee Year of Mercy.
