The Chicken BBQ, worked on successfully by about 10-percent of our Council 7613 members (40 Brother Knights) grossed a profit of \$2,700. The entire effort included Chicken Preparation, Fire Starters, Cooks, Firemen, Packaging, Barrel Washers, and Sales.

Preparation for the Chicken BBQ was accomplished on Friday, May 4 by 11 of our Brother Knights. Each and every one of the chicken halves were inspected, cleaned up, and seasoned. Another part of the preparation work involved the cleaning and foil wrapping of hundreds of Irish potatoes. DGK Andy Totah was born and raised in Palestine Texas. He has been a Knight since 1982. Both of his grandfathers and his dad were 4th degree Knights. His Dad is a Past Grand Knight. His mother is pictured below. His father's mother was born in Jerusalem, Palestine and moved to Palestine Texas.

Andy will have been married to Angi for 33 years this August. Both he and Angi share the same birthday, but he is a year older. As shown below, Andy has 4 children (2 boys ages 30 & 23) & 2 girls (ages 31 & 29) all of which are employed. He also has two granddaughters ages 5 & 3 (see all below). Andy is a graduate of Texas A&M with a degree in Finance. His first job was as a stockbroker, then he managed a Savings and Loan. Later he joined his Dad's family retail clothing business in 1987. He and Angi bought the business in 1993 then closed it in 2007. Andy has worked with three of his grandparents, both of his parents, his wife and all of his children.

While in Palestine, Texas, Andy spent numerous years coaching youth basketball, baseball and soccer. He was on the United Way Board, William Ingram Scholarship Board, President of the Jaycees, President of the Soccer Association, President of the YMCA, and President of the School Board. He served numerous years on these boards. He grew up as an altar boy, lector and usher. He was on the first degree team for many years in Palestine. He lived in Palestine for 50 years until moving to San Antonio in 2009.

Andy was a Reebok and YMCA Certified Fitness instructor for several years. He ran one marathon plus two half marathons. From year 1983 to 2002 he coached Youth Basketball at the YMCA, Youth Baseball and Youth Soccer. Andy also caddied for his son in numerous golf tournaments. Andy loves to hunt and play poker. He hunts dove, duck and deer with both of his sons and his son in law.

Andy and his wife Angi joined Holy Trinity when they first moved to San Antonio. Going from knowing almost everyone in a town that you have lived in your entire life to knowing only 6 people in San Antonio was a little difficult at first for Andy.

About 4 years ago Andy moved again and joined St. Marks where he met SK Steve Rohrbough after mass during a Chicken BBQ. It was then that Steve invited Andy to a Council 7613 meeting. All those of our Council made Andy feel very welcome when he transferred his membership to Council 7613.
