#### **Our Knights of Columbus License Plates**

In a recent Council meeting, the idea was raised about having Knights of Columbus vanity license plates produced and made available to members of our Council and Assembly. The plates are made of aluminum and overprinted as shown above. The plates have 2 mounting holes near the top for easy mounting. There are also 2 mounting holes at the bottom of the plate. If it is desired to also use the lower holes on the plate, there is a simple pop-out to make these holes apparent. Some modern vehicles may not appear to have mounting holes on the front bumpers but since these cars are sold in all states and many states require front license plates, there are almost always 2 lightly marked spots on the front bumper that are also pop- outs. The plates are available for \$12 and can be obtained from Brother Knight Nic DiGiacomo, who is in charge of these project. Don't delay since a modest number of plates were produced. This is a new Council fund raising project.
