## From the Desk of Fr. Joe Kannappel

Beloved Body of Christ at St. James,

**Christ lives in the Church!** Jesus promised this to the disciples when he said: "See, I am with you always, even to the end of the

world." In the last months of construction, many people have commented that "the church is beautiful" and my reply has been "YES and the building is wonderful too!" It is truly an external expression of the inner reality of the people who worship here: wonderful, fantastic, impressive, wow, awesome, better than imagined, gorgeous, giving glory to God. For seven years, I have experienced the committed discipleship of this faith community and I believe our newly renovated church reflects who we are when we GATHER for worship and GO forth to serve!

For the last 371 days, 22 hours, 2 minutes and 2 seconds, from April 18, 2015 to April 24, 2016 we have been wandering about Kearney for our liturgies and meeting spaces.
