Brothers, the month of June brings many happy occasions. There are anniversaries, birthdays, graduations and mostly about Dad. The American Father's Day began in Spokane, Washington, in 1910, with the daughter of a widow. When Sonora Smart Dodd heard a Mother's Day sermon in church, she approached her pastor, believing that fathers like hers—a Civil war veteran and single father who had raised six children—deserved recognition, too. Following the initial few years, Father's Day was all but lost until Dodd returned to Spokane, once again promoting her holiday. Despite support by trade groups and the Father's Day Council, Father's Day was rejected by both the general public and Congress until 1966. President Richard Nixon signed the holiday into law in 1972.

The official holiday has been in effect for 41 years in the United States, although similar celebrations have been in existence around the globe for much longer. In traditionally Catholic countries, fathers are popularly recognized on the Feast of St. Joseph. Please come celebrate with us on Sunday June 19th at the picnic shelter. If you cannot celebrate with the Council, may you have a wonderful time with your children and grandchildren in all that is festive that day.




