CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE — REV. FR. FRANK WAGNER, CSC

My Brother Knights,

I want to share with you a reflection made by our Bishop Crosby of the Diocese of Hamilton regarding this year's Week for Life and the Family with the theme, "Love Grows by Giving" He said, "None of us is unaware of, or immune to, the pain created by the great challenges confronting contemporary families."

The Bishop noted that the Bishops of Canada observed:

Virtually every form of poverty — material, emotional, moral or spiritual — has its origin in some kind of deprivation within the family. What is most lacking today is love — the kind of love that Jesus Christ came to give; a love which gives without counting the cost; a transformative love which can be found in its perfection only in Him who is love incarnate and in whom we can be transformed and empowered to love just as He loves. To a society confused about the nature of love, Pope Francis offers a piercingly insightful reflection on love's true meaning in his recent Apostolic Exhortation *Amoris Laetitia* [the Joy of Love].

In this my last letter to you as chaplain, I hope that every Knight will read Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation *Amoris Laetitia* which so wisely sums up the Synods on the Family. Read especially Chapter Four where the Pope does a beautiful meditation on the passage about charity which St. Paul wrote two millennia ago. All of us Knights need to remember that if all the works we do are lacking charity, then we have failed to be true to the various degrees of our Columbian brotherhood.

Family Life

To help families be together and have fun, Council 5073 can offer ready-made activities that require families only to participate. Here are a few of many.

- Plan a special social night honouring Family of the Month and Family of the Year.
- Submit Family of the Year selection to the state council for consideration as the jurisdiction's Family of the Year and possible consideration as the Supreme Council Family of the Year.
- Plan an annual marriage vow renewal program for couples in our council or the entire parish, working with our chaplain to plan a Mass or prayer service during which married couples renew their vows. (A certificate to present to each couple is available through the Supply Department.)

These are a few more ways we can be a catalyst to increasing family time.
