As we bring this Fraternal Year to a close it is time to reflect and celebrate our young Council's successes. It was only two years ago that Juan and a few hearty souls had a vision of St. Robert's having its own Council, and look at us today!

STAR Council is the highest award a Council can receive and we are being told that we meet all the requirements. There are a number of requirements including meeting your new members quota, but the real measure is what has a Council done in the areas listed below, with a minimum of four activities/projects in each area. But awards are only as good as what they represent: in our case—the dedication of a band of brothers committed to doing their part in helping to support our Parish and our Community through acts of charity and service.

I believe the list speaks for itself —- we've been a very busy Council this past year! Be proud of what we've accomplished!

Church Activities:

In participation with Men's Ministry, we have a leadership role in assisting with lawn care and snow removal In participation with Men's Ministry, several Knights painted the Parish Center, hallway and vestibule Several of our Knights are active in various Church Ministries: Eucharistic Ministers, Lectures, Ushers, etc. We provided financial support to the KofC State Missouri Religious Vocations Fund We provided financial support and exceeded our KofC State Religious Information Bureau quota (116%)

We purchased and distributed "A Guide to Confession" pamphlets to all of our parishioners to assist with their Lenten journey.

Community Activities:

We raised \$ 705 in our annual Tootsie Roll Drive for Persons with Developmental Disabilities— our portion of the proceeds went to Special Olympics

Several Knights assisted with the preparation of sack lunches for the local Special Olympics meet Two of our Knights organized a Christmas clothing and gift drive for the Flood of Joy, Missionary Baptist Church We purchased a wheel chair in support of the KofC State Wheel Chair program

Several of our Knights participated and assisted with the annual St. Robert Bellarmine Men's Ministry Golf Tournament

Our council sponsored the KofC annual "Roses for Life" campaign in our parish Our council assisted in collecting petition signatures in behalf of Pro-Life legislation We sponsored and distributed the "Carnations for Life" on Mother's Day in our parish Several Knights are active members on the St. Robert Bellarmine Pro-Life Committee We provided financial support to the St. Robert Bellarmine Pro-Life Committee

Youth Activities:

Ten Council members assist on a monthly basis the local Optimist Club raise funds for their various youth projects

KofC State Council Convention Report

Henry Marsh and I attended the 110th Annual Convention representing you.

It was quite an eye opener as to how our small council's efforts geometrically explode when multiplied by all the other councils in this state, country, and yes, even the world!

- Tootsie Roll Drive for Persons with Developmental Disabilities, the state raised almost \$628,000.
- On target to raise \$60,000 for Special Olympics
- On target to raise \$280,00 for R.I.B. (KofC program to spread the Word of God and Catholicism). We also received a free R.I.B. board for displaying Catholic literature at our events.
- Over \$22,500 donated to various Religious Vocations programs throughout the state.
- \$40,000 given out in Catholic Education Grants.
- 82,000 Roses for Life distributed throughout the state.
- Over \$53,000 raised for the Vitae Foundation that supports pro-life advertising.
- 40 wheelchair donations.
- State Ultra Sound Initiative Place an Ultra Sound machine in every Pregnancy Resource Center in Missouri—purchased 5 this year.
