ANNUAL KNIGHT'S OF COLUMBUS PILGRIMAGE - October 7th

This year the Knight's of Columbus Pilgrimage will be on Sunday, October 7th in Perryville, Missouri at : "The National Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal".

There will be a 47 passenger motor coach bus leaving from the parking lot of St. Bernadette's Catholic Church on Saturday, October 6th at noon. St. Bernadette's address is 9020 E 51st Terr, Kansas City, MO 64133.

Arrangements have been made to stay overnight at Comfort Inn in Perryville. Twenty- six double rooms and 6 single rooms have been blocked for this date. The cost for the round trip bus will be \$44.00 per person. Cost for the motel will be \$71.99 single or double. No taxes. This motel has a Free Sunshine Breakfast.

On our way to Perryville, the bus will make a quick stop about half way for a late lunch, probably fast food.

After check in, all of us will go to a local restaurant, at a mutually agreed upon time and location, for a dinner meal at our own expense. After breakfast on Sunday, we will leave for the site. Our tentative schedule is:

10:00 - 10:45 Registration, with coffee and donuts

11:00 - Mass
12:30 - Stations / Rosary
1:30 - Lunch (on you at site)
3:00 - Tour of Shrine Church
Arrive back home at approximately 9:00 PM.

I have arranged all of this to make it as easy as possible. I have blocked the rooms on my own credit card, and I have reserved the bus. If you want to reserve a seat on the bus and a room at the motel, package deal only, you need to call me, Ed Columbus at 816-358-8831. I Realize this Pilgrimage is four months away, but to assure a place you probably need to move as soon as you have a chance to discuss this with your loved ones. Unfortunately, as nice as I am, and to keep harmony in my house, I will not pay for a full bus and 31 rooms at the motel.
