- A. The <u>Georgia State Council meeting</u> was held via conference in May; meeting was presentation by state councils to recognize individuals and passing of Knights.
- B. <u>Deacon Dave Fragale</u> is still in Emory Hospital recovering from a liver transplant as well as other complications; he's receiving physical therapy.
- C. The Knights will help brother <u>Ted Waldbart</u> with a planned move this Saturday, June 6<sup>th</sup>. Roger will send out an email requesting volunteers/trucks.
- D. The Council will have a <u>General Business meeting</u> next Tuesday, June 9<sup>th</sup> via on-line Zoom. Meeting will include the voting of officers for 2020-2021.

  Discussion regarding the type of voting (voice, hand signal, etc.) as well as approving potential new candidates.

- E. <u>Officer positions</u>: there are still 4 or 5 open positions, but some positions may not be critical during this time of on-line meeting, and can be filled/voted on during the July 2020 meeting.
