- The annual Parish Carnival will be held this weekend, September 6, 7, and 8. The Knights will run the corn and potato booth as we have in the past. The trucks that were used to transport produce to the booth in the past may not be available this year, so some pickups may be needed to fill in for that. - Brother Denny Morrow will need help around 1PM Thursday to transfer produce from one truck to another. He plans to park near the Perpetual Adoration chapel. Meet him there if you can help.
- **Grapefest** is scheduled for September 12 - 15, and volunteers are needed to serve wine samples. As in the past, the Council will be paid \$8 for every hour of volunteer time. This is the only fundraiser we have where we don't solicit the parish.
