### *Without a Caterer*

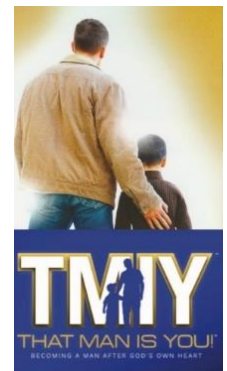
