No outside beverages are permitted. A bartender is included with hall rental and drinks must be purchased through the bar.

The lower level is named in honor of our newsletter's former editor and is called the Bill Wolf Memorial Club Room. Rental of this room is \$250 with a \$200 deposit. Room seats up to 90 people. There is a kitchen and refrigerator available and included with lower hall rental.
