Did You Know...

The Knights of Columbus initiated a campaign in 1951 to lobby for the public adoption of the phrase "under God" in the U.S. Pledge of Allegiance. The Order's Board of Directors had amended the recitation at Fourth Degree and assembly meetings encouraged national representatives to adopt the same language nationwide. One year after Knight Hart took office in 1953, President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed a law that officially added the words "under God" to the pledge.
