MEMBERSHIP SURVEY

We thank all members who took the opportunity to share their interests and concerns with the Council in the 2011 Membership Survey. Just over 30% of the members (113 out of 380 total) returned the survey - a significant percentage. Now begins the task of summarizing the data and comments - and then acting on the wishes expressed. At the meeting in June we saw the first glimpse of all this data -a breakout of the demographics (Age and Years of Membership) of the responders (Age and Years of Membership) vs. the council as a whole. A significant statistic was that our newest members (less than 5 years with the Order) responded strongly to the survey. Although they are only 13% of our Council, they provided 20% of the responses we received. This indicates that they want to be involved and offer their ideas.
