SPECIAL MEETING REPORT

On December 12, members of the Architectural Committee made a presentation to approximately 75 members of the Council and Ladies Auxiliary. The purpose was to review architectural drawings and cost estimates surrounding a proposed new hall. The committee outlined the approach and walked the audience through the drawings. Unfortunately, the total cost estimate of \$ 1.45 million dollars is beyond our reach at the moment. The committee did receive positive feedback and were encouraged to continue efforts to maintain the vision as presented. The committee will attempt to find ways to cut cost while at the same time evaluate fundraisers to address the cost differential. The architectural drawings will be posted at the hall if you wish to review. The committee will be providing the Council with an update within the next 6 months.

HOOPS MANIA FUND RAISER FOR OUR NEW HALL

At the meeting on December the 12^{th} , we agreed that we needed to start more fundraising to make our new hall a reality. At the Council meeting on December 20th the Council voted to try Hoops Mania as the first of our new fundraisers. The contest is based around the 2013 NCAA basketball tournament. We sell a \$10 ticket and the buyer gets a chance to win one of 49 prizes ranging from \$1000 to \$20, based on the points scored by the 8 random teams that they are assigned.
