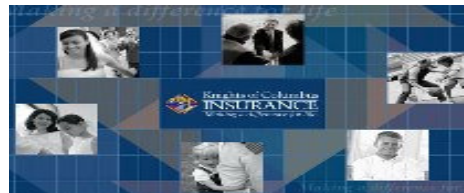

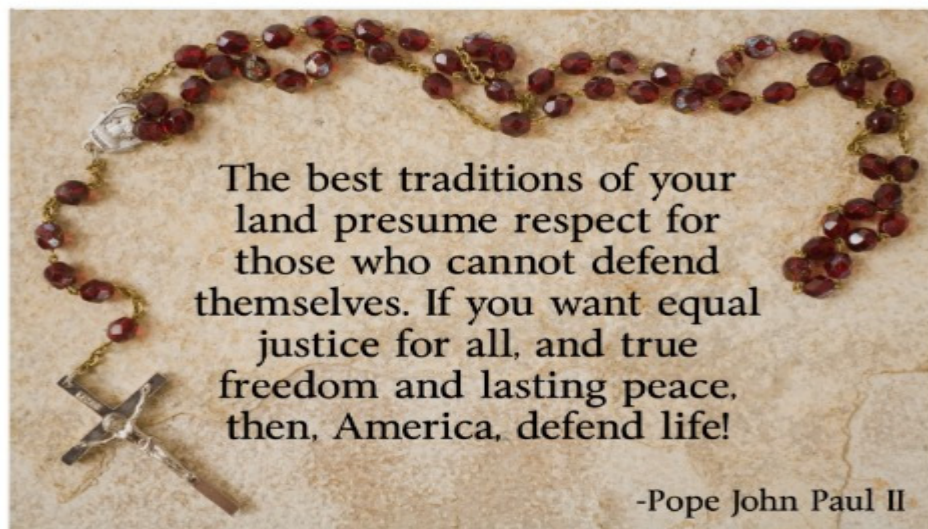
All are invited to attend.
