¶Stipulations include St. Andrew Church use for stained glass windows; St. Andrew School Tuition assistance be used at the rate of \$1,000. per year over a 5 year period; and that, at the request of Fr. Jeffrey Kirby, Vicar for Vocations, money is used for improvements to the Wentworth House. *Having been duly introduced at the preceding regular business meeting and published in the council newsletter no later than October 27, 2013, there will be a vote of the attending membership of Council #5086 at the next regularly scheduled business meeting, Monday, 7 PM, November 4, 2013, by written ballot. If 2/3 of the Knights attending vote YES to accept the Final Plan, it will be deemed approved for expense.
