The annual "Nine Cities Blood Drive" involving 9 Coachella Valley communities will be taking place during July. Each city has a designated day for donations; each donor receives a complimentary, single-day admission ticket to Wet 'n Wild Palm Springs. If you are interested, the specific dates and locations are available by calling LifeStream or going to their website. Free \$10 gas cards are being given out every Friday during July for whole blood and apheresis donors. In addition, apheresis donor making donations on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, or Sundays will receive a gas card. Any donation during the month of July registers you for a drawing for a pair of triple-play Southern California City Passes (single day admissions to Disneyland, Disney's California Adventure, Sea World, and Legoland. Four pairs of passes are given out each week of the month.
