DEBT INSURANCE

One of the top goals of all working couples is to become debt free by retirement. But as late as 2003, 30% of all retiring couples could not succeed accomplishing this. In 2007, 53% did the same. Blood Bank Notes

Fellow Knights: We had 5 donations to our account during the month of April 2014; thank you to those who were able to donate.

The liquid portion of our blood is called plasma; it is the solution in which our red blood cells, white blood cells, and platelets are suspended while circulating throughout our veins and arteries. Consisting primarily of water (about 92 percent) its functions include maintaining proper blood pressure, supplying blood clotting factors to injury sites, delivering antibodies to fight infections, and balancing the pH (acidity) of our circulatory system. It also contains glucose and other nutrients for our body's tissues. Plasma is collected by removal of the cells from the blood. If immediately frozen (within 24 hours), it can be stored up to a year for eventual use with trauma patients who are in need of its clotting factors or to cardiac patients. It can also be separated or 'fractionated' into several derivatives each of which can be used for specific purposes. Plasma which has the clotting factors removed is called serum; this can be recognized as the liquid that oozes near a scab formation around a wound. Donors are permitted to give one unit of plasma per month.

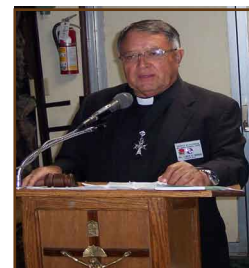

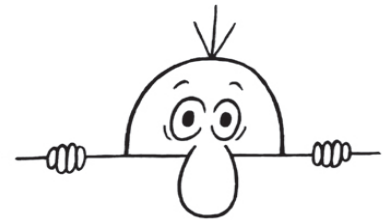
