Council Donations

As is our custom, the Council has made end of (Columbian) year donations to various charities and schools in the amounts available from our fundraising events during the year. The total amount was \$31,200, not counting about \$3000 donations during the year and \$5730 to the Parish pro-life committee as their share of the Super 50-50 proceeds. Additionally, the Council voted to accumulate up to \$3000 per year leading up to the 250th anniversary of St. Mary of the Assumption Parish in 2022. So, we could potentially have \$12,000 available for use at that time.

Thank you to all the Event Chairmen, Brother Knights and Ladies Auxiliary whose dedication makes possible this manifestation of our Order's First Principle of Charity.






