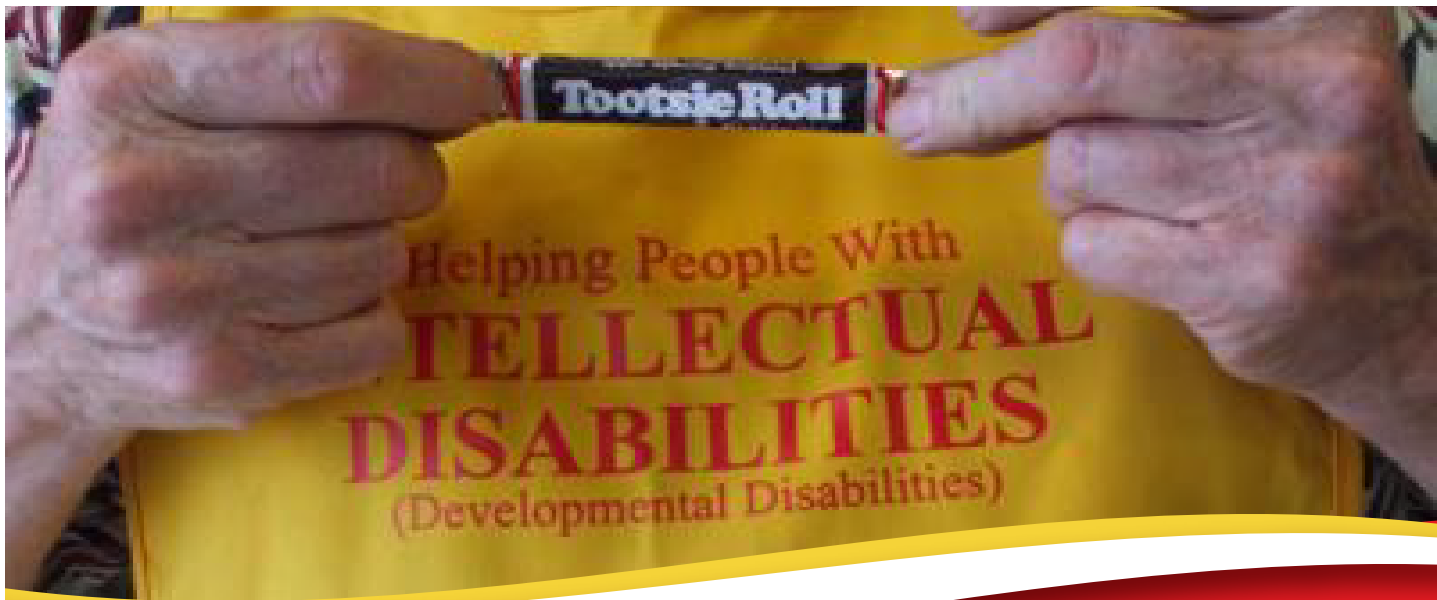
Brothers,

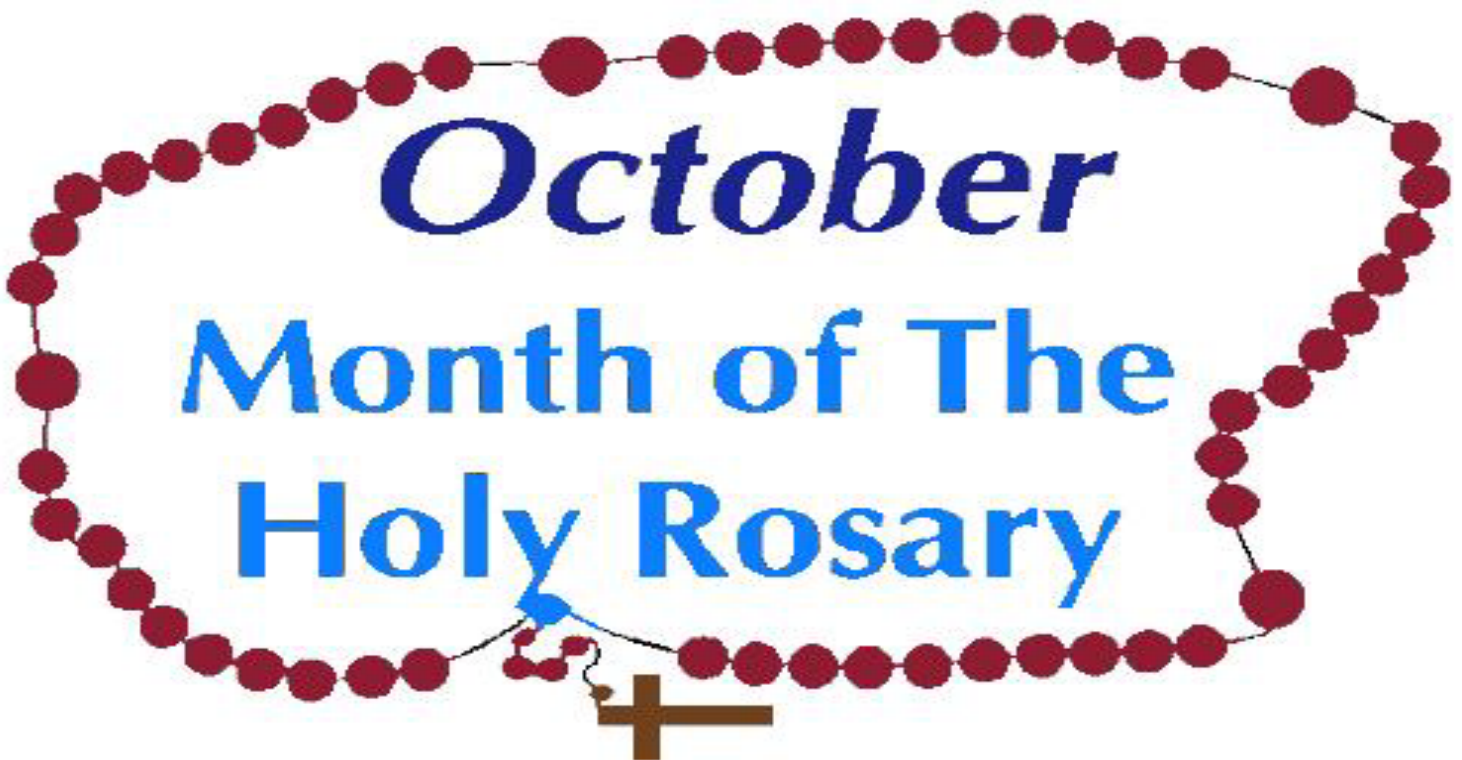


Brother Knights and friends,

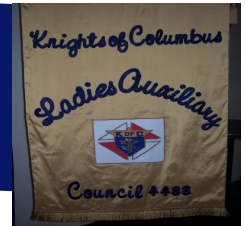
