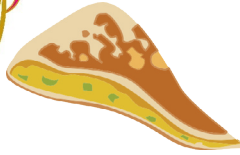

Knights Of Columbus Ladies Auxiliary Council 4488



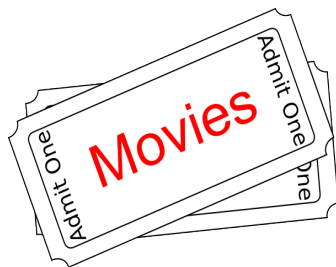

Culture of Life

Houston, TX - On July 26, the Harris County District Attorney's Office asked a judge to dismiss the felony counts it had filed against David Daleiden and Sandra Merritt, undercover journalists with the Center for Medical Progress, who exposed Planned Parenthood's (PP) participation in the illegal trafficking of aborted baby remains for profit. "This is vindication of the work of David Daleiden and the Center for Medical Progress. I am so pleased that justice has prevailed! These false charges can no longer be used by (PP) and their cronies as a smokescreen to hide their own criminal conduct," said Troy Newman, President of Operation Rescue and a founding board member for the Center for Medical Progress. Daleiden and Merritt had originally faced one felony each for using actor's I.D.s and a misdemeanor count for attempting to purchase aborted baby organs from (PP) high-volume late-term abortion facility in Houston, Texas. The misdemeanor counts were earlier dismissed. Even if no charges are brought against (PP) for its phony legal suit, the outcome of this travesty may serve as evidence for congress to refuse any request by (PP) for funds. At least, we hope so!
