


# Grents

## In the Spirit

#### The Life of Man—To Know and Love God

- God, infinitely perfect and blessed in himself, in a plan of sheer goodness freely created man to make him share in his own blessed life. For this reason, at every time and in every place, God draws close to man. He calls man to seek him, to know him, to love him with all his strength. He calls together all men, scattered and divided by sin, into the unity of his family, the Church. To accomplish this, when the fullness of time had come, God sent his Son as Redeemer and Savior. In his Son and through him, he invites men to become, in the Holy Spirit, his adopted children and thus heirs of his blessed life.
- So that this call should resound throughout the world, Christ sent forth the apostles he had chosen, commissioning them to proclaim the gospel: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age." 4 Strengthened by this mission, the apostles "went forth and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with them and confirmed the message by the signs that attended it."
- Those who with God's help have welcomed Christ's call and freely responded to it are urged on by love of Christ to proclaim the Good News everywhere in the world. This treasure, received from the apostles, has been faithfully guarded by their successors. All Christ's faithful are called to hand it on from generation to generation, by professing the faith, by living it in fraternal sharing, and by celebrating it in liturgy and prayer.




#### DAVID WILLIAMS

Dear Friends,

It's baseball season again as the Knights invite you to register for our spring and summer 2015 game, "Play Baseball with the Knights."

It couldn't be simpler to play. Here's how it works. Each registered participant will receive a randomly drawn "Play Baseball with the Knights" certificate for the 2015 baseball season. Each certificate will have the names of three National League Baseball Teams. These three teams are your participating teams for the entire 26-week baseball season and will determine whether or not you are a winner in our game.

#### THERE WILL BE A WINNER EVERY WEEK!

Each week of the season our "Play Baseball" committee will total the number of runs each National League team scores during games played that week ( for the purpose of this game, a week is defined as beginning on Monday and ending the following Sunday). The holder of the certificate with the three teams that scored the highest combined total number of runs that week will be awarded an amount based on the number of tickets sold. (\$A)

If no one has purchased that ticket, the holder of the highest points sold will be awarded (\$B) 60% of the award for that week. The 40% will be added to next weeks awards. (A & 40%) The holder of the certificate with the three teams that scored the fewest combined total number of runs that week will be awarded an amount determined by participation.(C) Multiple winners divide the award.

For example, if 300 tickets were sold, A=\$105, B=\$63, C=\$35.

The weekly award amounts (A, B, C) will be posted at WWW, Holy INFAMI - KOFC, ORG. You register once and you're eligible all 26 weeks. It's that easy.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE ENTIRE SEASON COSTS ONLY \$25.00 (THAT'S LESS THAN \$1.00 PER WEEK TO PLAY). To register for the 2015 season complete the enclosed form and return it by March 20<sup>th</sup> with \$25.00. Then, look for your certificate(s) in time for Opening Day of the 2015 baseball season.
