

From the Deacon's Desk

Lent 2020 – I have to find myself again.

Ash Wednesday heralds the start of Lent. The signing with ashes has biblical roots. Look up these references – 2 Sam 13:19, Est 4:1, Is 61:3, Est 4:3, Jer 6:26, Ez 27:30, Dn 9:3, Mt 11:21, Lk 10:13.

Lent is a time for spiritual introspection – fancy word for trying to figure out if we're on the heavenly track. We do this by fasting, abstaining, reading Scripture, meditating, praying, and the Sacrament of Reconciliation.



Yes, the Sacrament of Reconciliation should be on your bucket list of Lenten activities. Be thankful that you were born in the current period. In the early middle ages Ash Wednesday penitents dressed in sackcloth, would present themselves before the bishop, would have ashes placed on their heads, and then would be expelled from the church for 40 days. Your penance would most often include fasting for several years. Having bad thoughts would get you 7 days of bread and water. Irish monks were creative.

When setting up your March calendar, mark the times parishes have weekly and parish Lenten Reconciliation Services. I doubt any priest is going to assign bread and water (hopefully)




