**Free Throw Contest** – We partnered with Arch Angel Council #7429 to sponsor this year's contest at Our lady of Mt. Carmel School on February 14<sup>th</sup>. While participation was down a bit due to the President's weekend vacation, we had 23 participants and sent our winners on to the regional finals. The contest ran smoothly due to the good turn out by Knights from both Councils. Thanks to everyone who volunteered their time. ## From the Financial Secretary

Dues paid by Council members help underwrite our charitable activities, as well as our activities in support of the Church and the youth of the Parish.
